TO ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS:

Surveys and Plans, General Letter, 1958 - #12 issued August 21, 1958 furnished the District and Urban Offices with a copy of a pamphlet titled "A Guide for the Design of Ground Water Supplies", which pamphlet reflects the minimum requirements of the Missouri Division of Health. That pamphlet included a section on the requirements for disinfecting water mains which affects our projects where work on city water distribution systems are involved. The American Water Works Association procedure for disinfecting water mains, which by reference is included in the Division of Health's pamphlet, has been printed in a convenient form and a copy is attached for your information.

We are also attaching a copy of a Special Provision for Disinfecting Water Mains which has been used on several projects and has been found to be satisfactory. This provision complies with the Division of Health's requirements and the American Water Works Association's procedure and is to be used on all future projects where work on city water distribution systems is included in our contract work.
