TO ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS:

Attached hereto is a print of the latest "Table of General Design Data", dated September 1, 1960.

On August 1, 1960, we sent you Surveys and Plans Design Letter No. 22 to which was attached a print of the Table of General Design Data, dated June 1, 1960. Since then several changes have been made in the table. They are as follows:

1. "Non-Passing Sight Distance" was changed to read "Stopping Sight Distance."
2. Maximum curvature in "Flat" terrain with the traffic "under 100" was changed from 15° to 14°.
3. Paragraph (d) pertaining to minimum diameter of pipe culverts for cross-road structures was added under the "General Notes".
4. The note regarding shoulder widening for guard rail was changed in order to clarify its meaning.
5. The 18" minimum diameter for cross-road structures does not apply to sewers and the draining of the median. A note to that effect has been added.
