**SUPPLEMENTARY HIGHWAYS AND LOCAL ROADS - NO. 7, 1960
LEGAL**

TO ALL DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS:

Effective July 21, 1960, the Chief Engineer authorized payment for non-contractual costs less than \$2000 from state funds without obtaining federal participation. This authorization applies to bridge repairs, bridge painting, work by District forces, right-of-way, utility adjustments and other non-contractual items costing less than \$2000.

Effective at once, all utility adjustments costing less than \$2000 shall be considered as a right-of-way item and shall be handled directly with the legal Division as provided in the Chief Engineer's letter of February 18, 1959, for adjustments costing less than \$500. This change is not considered retroactive and will not affect items for which PS&E documents have been submitted to the Bureau of Public Roads.
