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**TO ALL DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS:**

**This is with reference to our letter of February 7, 1961, furnishing you with sample plan-profile sheets and requesting your preference regarding information on these sheets. Our belated handling of this matter was caused by some of you not furnishing us with replies by the deadline, as requested in our letter of February 7. The last reply was received by this office today.**

**The majority of the Districts favor the plan-profile sheets with no contours, which was Example Sheet No. 3, furnished with our letter. Therefore, we will proceed with preparing manuscripts on the basis of reproducing plan-profile sheets in this form.**

**While it is very desirable that a uniform method of procedure be used, we can furnish plan-profile sheets with contours if you determine that contours are desirable in special cases. We would like to hold the special cases to a very minimum. In order to reproduce contours it will be necessary that the manuscripts be prepared accordingly. Therefore, if in special cases it is your desire to have contours reproduced on plan-profile sheets, it will be necessary that you advise this office prior to our starting the preparation of manuscripts.**

**We will proceed on this basis, at least for the time being, and if, at a later date, we determine it is desirable to change the procedure, we will, of course, do so. We will continue the past practice of furnishing you with manuscripts including contours, where contours are drawn.**
