Subject: Erasers for Milar Drafting Material

TO ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS:

It has come to our attention that some of the Districts are encountering trouble with replacing notes after erasing and eradicating on the Milar plan and profile sheets being furnished by the Photogrammetric Unit.

Pencil notes can be removed by use of A. W. Faber Castell Erasers No. 1954 and Bruning Nu-White Erasers No. 3833 for erasing machines. Both of these will be available from Headquarters Garage stock in the near future.

Pencil notes can also be removed by washing with a cloth moistened with water or solvent. The erased area must be allowed to dry before re-penciling.

Care must be used so as not to over-erase or over-wet, as this may completely destroy the mat surface, leaving only the film base which will not accept pencil readily.

The printed data can be removed from the back of the material by use of Dietzgen Van Dyke Eradicator No. 233E. This is available from Headquarters Garage stock.
