Subject: Entrances to Weigh Stations

Body

ALL DIVISION , DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS:

The matter of entrances to weigh stations from outer roadways has been reviewed with the Legal Division for the purpose of determining the proper method of showing such entrances on the plans for Limited Access highways. It was decided that the plans should show the location of the entrance without indicating terminal points on the 'NO RIGHT OF ACCESS' line located at the inside shoulder of the outer roadway, since the entrance will serve the weighing station only and is not for public use. The plans should indicate the type of entrance by the notation "Gate Entrance - For Official Use of Weighing Station Only". Other data pertinent to the entrance shall be listed on the B-sheet under Entrances and Approaches.

This letter supersedes General Letter No. 11, 1962, of like title, dated May 2, 1962, and you are requested to destroy all copies of that letter.
