**Subject: Special Provisions and Standard Drawings**

## Body

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ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL

We are furnishing you under separate cover, several copies of the following new or revised special provisions and standard drawing.

Railroad Ditches. This is a new special provision setting out the specific responsibility of the contractor with respect to maintenance of railroad ditches. This special provision is to be used only for grade separations with railroads.

Highway Signing. Page 11 of this special provision has been revised. Section 72.2.12.1 now specifies that the lengths of posts will be checked in the field by the engineer "after the rough grading has been completed". Section 72.2.12.4 was revised to delete the words "only as required".

Standard Drawing 72.03, Sheet 6, has been revised to include a punching detail for the mile marker posts and delineator posts giving the fabricator the permissible option of punching each post with the maximum number of holes.

All of the preceding will be effective for the August, 1964 Letting.
