ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL

We are attaching a copy of the approved aerial photography program for the coming flying season. New projects are tentatively scheduled subject to the completion of necessary reconnaissance and location approval. We will not obtain photography on these projects until the centerline is established or the location is sufficiently firm on post flight projects where the geodimeter will be used for horizontal control in lieu of centerline surveys.

You may proceed with the surveying of the centerline on those projects on which you have been furnished approval dates for preliminary engineering. It is our desire to obtain as much of this aerial photography as early in the flying season as possible, and this office will appreciate your cooperation in completing your portion of the work as early as possible.

When submitting the county or city map with the designated centerline, please advise the exact station of any scale changes in order that the Photogrammetry unit can properly plan the vertical control to obtain the proper compilation scale.

Please contact this office on any matter and at any time necessary to expedite the completion of the field work before the photography season is ended.

If there are any additions, deletions, or changes in this listing from that which was recommended by you, we will furnish a separate letter explaining same.
