Subject: Basic Lighting at Ramp Terminals

Body

ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

Paragraphs 15.1.2.2.1.2 and 15.1.3.1.4 of our Design Manual required basic lighting at the ramp terminals when the intersection is channelized. This is true, regardless of the traffic volumes involved and other warrants for lighting.

Channelization of intersections which otherwise will not warrant basic lighting, is to receive prior approval by this office before proceeding with the final development of detail plans.

We should try to eliminate the necessity of lighting intersections due entirely to the use of channelized layouts. Please give this matter careful consideration on all future projects other than those included in January and February, 1965 Lettings.
