Subject: I.M. 30-6-64 Certification of Consultant

ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

Attached is Bureau of Public Roads Instructional Memorandum 30-6-64, dated December 24, 1964, with an effective date of January 15, 1965. This memorandum concerns the employment by a utility or a railroad of the services of a consultant to accomplish an adjustment of their facilities for a highway improvement project.

When federal funds are involved, compliance with this memorandum will require that one copy of the "Certification of Consultant" be furnished the Division of Surveys and Plans as follows:

- (1) When a utility company proposed to use a consultant in accordance with the terms of a continuing contract, an executed copy of the "Certification of Consultant:" should accompany each request sent to the Main Office for approval, or
- (2) When the utility company requests the employment of a consultant other than under the terms of a continuing contract, Main Office approval for the use of the consultant will be contingent upon the utility company furnishing, immediately following the award of a contract to the consultant, one executed copy of the certification.
