ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

We are transmitting, under separate cover, several copies of the following new or revised pages in the Design Manual.

Page 1.5 has been revised and Page 1.6 has been added in order to bring up to date the list of available forms for Surveys and Plans, Blue Print Room, Photogrammetry, and Computer.

One important change is the consolidation of the former Forms SP-20 Highway-Railroad Crossing Data, and SH-21 Highway-Railroad Crossing Data for Supplementary Highways and Local Roads. These two forms have been combined into a single Form SP-20 Highway-Railroad Crossing Data which will be used for all crossings as set out in Section IX Utilities of the Design Manual. Please note that only two copies for each crossing need be furnished by the District. A supply of this revised form is included with this transmittal.

Figure 7.14 has been added to illustrate Form SP-103 Requisition for Ground Photography.

Page 10.9 Section 10.4.2 has been revised to include required information necessary when skewed grade separations over railroads are involved. This information is essentially that which was included in General Letter No. 2, 1962, dated January 9, 1962. Pages 10.10 and 10.11 have been retyped to provide space for the preceding revision.

SECTION IX UTILITIES

This entire section, including the table of contents, text, and figures, except Figure 9.1, has been revised in accordance with the approved Commission Policy on Location of Utility Facilities on State Highways. The issuance of this revised section supersedes and renders void all previous general letters pertaining to utilities. Since this is a complete revision, the entire section should be carefully reviewed in detail.

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
