ALL DIVISION, DISTRICT AND URBAN ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

General Letter No. 60, 1964, dated December 4, 1964, set out certain criteria for transitioning to the use of revised pavement crowns or cross slopes. It was left to the discretion of the District to transition to the use of the revised typical sections and standard drawings as rapidly as possible.

The revised standard drawing affected are 21.00, 21.10, 21.30, 21.31, 21.60, 21.61, and 43.10, all of which carry a revision date of 12-7-64.

Sufficient time has now elapsed to fully implement the use of these revised standard drawings. All plans submitted to this office on or after July 1, 1965, should be based on the revised standard drawings.

Exceptions to the use of these revised drawings and typical sections are expected to be rare and all exceptions should be fully explained and justified in the letter of transmittal of the plans.
