MEMORANDUM TO DESIGNERS:

Mr. McLaughlin has requested that the matter of property entrances be carefully reviewed on plans designed for limited access right-of-way. He is concerned with proper application of Commission policy, especially on new locations (Bypass Routes). As you know, the policy states in part that no access shall be granted to those tracts or properties having reasonable access to another road. Please bear this in mind when reviewing right-of-way plans for approval.

If the plans deviate from the policy or are inconsistent in the access treatment to various properties, please call this to the District's attention. Remember the number of access points should be kept to a minimum on limited access highways in so far as possible. Any additional entrance must be justified by the District.
