ALL HIGHWAY DESIGN ENGINEERS AND REVIEWERS

Surveys and Plans' General Letter No. 7, 1966, issued February 17, 1966, sets out Policy on Maintenance Responsibility and Designations of Outer Roadways, Service Roads, and Relocated Roads. Since the new policy requires revised limited access notes, the following practice will henceforth be followed with respect to the filing of plans.

1. Initial Approval of Plans. - Use revised note applicable to the type of right-of-way involved for the particular improvement.
2. Revised approval of plans previously filed under the old note. - If changes in plans require refiling of an entire set of plans, it must be done using the proper revised note, regardless of whether or not service roads are involved. In other words, use the latest note, even though the original filing was done under the old note.
3. Amended approval substituting individual plan sheets in plans previously filed under the old note - Substitute the plan sheet (or sheets) that are changed and add the latest limited access note to the revised sheets, only if a service road is involved.
4. Approval of amended or revised plans previously filed under the latest (revised) notes. Refile plans or sheets as required. There will be no need for notes since the revised notes used in the initial filing will still apply.

This practice will become effective with the March meeting of the Commission, and the wording contained in the revised notes will be used in the Commission minutes on future approvals.
