**Subject: Revised Standard Drawings and Special Provisions**

## Body

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ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

We are furnishing you herewith several copies of the following revised Standard Drawings and Special Provisions, which will be used where applicable beginning with the January 20, 1967 Letting.

### Standard Drawings

Drawing 54.00. A note has been added under the General notes to require suitable plates or continuous bars on the feet of bar supports where they are placed on earth or aggregate subgrades.

Drawing 70.00. Deleted the 12 1/8-inch dimension from the plan view of the two-piece base cover. This cover is required to fit the pole and the 12 1/8-inch dimension in some cases could result in a conflict.

Drawing 71.00. Added "Class IV Pole" note to the drawing of the Power Supply Assembly.

Drawing 71.07. Deleted Type THWN wire from the note on the plan view of the Loop Slot Detail.

Drawing 72.03 (Sheet 5 of 5). All references to triple amber delineators have been deleted. Double amber delineators are now used at terminal points of the respective ramps.

### Special Provisions

Erosion Control - Mulching and Seeding. This special provision has been revised to require the contractor to rake mulch from certain ditches which drain into small drainage structures and to set out the measurement and payment therefore. A Design Manual revision concerning this subject was sent you by General Letter No. 30 - 1966. It is not anticipated that this revision will affect design plans; however, it will promote uniformity in the administration of the areas, including ditches and medians which are to be mulched.
