Subject: Revision in Width of Aggregate Base Under Portland Cement Concrete Pavements

ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSELS:

It has been the practice of the Department to extend the width of Type Three aggregate base material under Portland cement concrete pavements one foot beyond the pavement edge to provide support for the paving forms.

Based on a recent Design Committee action, the width of Type Three aggregate base material will be extended 18 inches beyond the pavement edge.

This revision is effective immediately, and all plans not yet submitted to this office should be revised accordingly.
