ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

We are attaching hereto several copies of the following listed and described special provisions and standard drawings to be used where applicable for the indicated letting.

Special Provision - Office for Engineer

This is a completely revised special provision for the temporary office for engineer. Please note that the pay item number 99001 is unchanged; however, payment will now be on a per month basis in lieu of the past lump sum. The number of months for bidding purposes will be that estimated for the total time to complete the project plus sufficient time to prepare final plans.

This special provision will be used beginning with the February 16, 1968 Letting.

Special Provision - Project Information Signs
(formerly Construction Identification Signs)

Standard Drawing 87.20

The special provision and standard drawing have been revised to provide a supplemental sign, identified as Sign B, to denote the amount (by percentage only) of participation in right-of-way costs by a local political subdivision. Sign B will be used only where there is local participation. Sign A is the same as previously used except that the legend and sign face size for the Interstate sign has been reduced to provide 4-foot by 8-foot overall size.

The District shall, as in past practice, indicate in the letter of transmittal of plans, estimate, and special provisions, the required number of Project Information Signs by designating the proper numbers of Sign A and of Sign B where applicable. If a Sign B is required, information for the message shall also be furnished in the letter of transmittal.

The above special provision and standard drawing will be used, where applicable, beginning with the March 29, 1968 letting. It is important that the Districts furnish this office the

necessary information for those projects for which plans have been submitted to the Main Office.

Standard Drawing 87.21

This drawing has been revised only to the extent of changing the title to conform to drawing 87.20, i.e., Project Information Signs. It is not anticipated that any supplemental sign will be necessary for this drawing.

This drawing will also be used where applicable, beginning with the March 29, 1968 Letting.
