Subject: Supplement to General Letter No. 13, 1968 - Fencing Policy

Body

ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

This letter is to further clarify implementation of the fencing policy and should be added to, and made a part of, General Letter No. 13, 1968, dated May 13, 1968.

While it is still not the intent of the policy to provide continuous fencing indiscriminately, additional emphasis should be placed on the requirement to fence in agricultural areas where the cultivating and the growing of crops on the right-of-way occurs.

Fencing should be provided when adjacent land is cultivated, should generally not be provided when adjacent land is only pasture land, and should not be provided when adjacent land is wooded.

Considerable judgment must be exercised in the placement of fencing on each project. All fence provided on a project will be maintained by the State.
