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ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

We are furnishing you herewith several copies of the following new or revised Special Provisions and Standard Drawings.

### SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Equal Employment Opportunity. This special provision will be used in All Federal Aid Projects, including demolition contracts prepared by the Districts, beginning with the July 1968 Letting.

This special should be listed on the Special Provisions Table of Contents of the proposal as the last item of supplements following the Anti-Collusion Statement.

Safety Projects. This special provision is actually a composite package of those applicable special provisions previously furnished you by General Letter No. 12, 1968, dated May 6, 1968, and the supplement to General Letter No. 12, 1968, dated May 27, 1968.

This special will be used beginning with the August 1968 Letting.

### STANDARD DRAWINGS

Drawings 70.00 and 70.01. These drawings have been revised to correct the bolt circle of the shoe base on 8 inch poles from 11 1/2 inches to 11 inches. This correction also affects the bolt circle on the steel pile foundation plate.

Drawing 86.00 (Sheet 1 of 5). This drawing has been revised to correct the hole locations in the intermediate terminal post connectors for posts No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3.

The above drawings will be used beginning with the August 1968 Letting.
