## Body

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ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS

We are furnishing you herewith several copies of the following revised Special Provision and standard drawing which will be used, where applicable, beginning with the October 24, 1968, letting.

### Special Provision

Portland Cement Concrete Base, Pavement, and Approach Slab for Bridges. Page 2 of this special has been revised to delete the 90 percent requirements, and to require all concrete with certain aggregates constructed and placed in accordance Sections 29, 48, and 48.30, to be placed on a polyethylene sheeting moisture barrier. Sampling and testing for thickness of the polyethylene material has been added.

Standard Drawing 23.10 - Typical Cross-Overs. The notes on this drawing have been revised as follows:

Type II cross-overs shall be constructed of the same material and thickness as the travel way.

Shoulders for Type I and Type II cross-overs shall be the same as the travel way shoulder.
