Subject: Job Special Provisions and SP-14

ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND CHIEF COUNSEL:

We are furnishing you herewith several copies of the following job special provisions and Form SP-14 (check list).

These job special provisions should be checked in red for applicable projects, as has been the practice in the past. These will then be added to the so called "ABC" special provisions written for the specific project. The Main Office, during the processing of proposals, prepares a Table of Contents of Job Special Provisions which lists the "ABC" special provisions with the indicated red checked job specials. Thus, all special provisions for the specific project, whether written individually or stocked in the Main Office, will be referred to as "Job Special Provisions".

The Table of Contents will appear in the proposal in the order assembled as illustrated by the following example:

JOB SPECIAL PROVISIONS TABLE OF CONTENTS

- A. General
- B. Detour and Handling Traffic
- C. Method of Transitioning
- D. MKT Railroad
- Shop and Field Welding
- Weigh Station Scale Pit and Scale

Please note that the special provisions entitled "Surfacing Sketch", "T-Bar Sketch", and "Office for Engineer (Permanent)" have been discontinued.

All of the other special provisions have either been incorporated into the Standard Specifications Book or will be furnished you shortly as Supplemental Specifications.

Railroad Protective Liability Insurance. This Special Provision is included, where applicable, by the Main Office. No copies are attached. No changes have been made.

Portland Cement Concrete Base, Pavement, and Approach Slab for Bridges. This special provision has been updated to comply with 1968 Specifications. The table for gradation has been deleted and reference to Gradation D has been added. The paragraph calling the contractor's attention to revised quality standards has been deleted. As in the past, this special should be used in all contracts containing the items of Portland cement concrete base, pavement, or approach slab for bridges.

Shop and Field Welding. This special provision is being rewritten by the Division of Bridges and is not complete at this time. It will, however, be included where applicable by the Main Office.

Weigh Station Scale Pit and Scale. This special provision has been updated to comply with the 1968 Specifications. Pay Item Number has been established.

Nondiscrimination in Employment. This special has been revised to update the section and paragraph reference to the Required Contract Provisions and to revise the two exemptions. No revision was made to the Statements and Payrolls portion.

Equal Employment Opportunity Notice. This special provision was revised to correct the numbered PR Forms in paragraph one (1), and the revision date of the EEO in paragraph two (2). No further changes were made.

Nonsegregated Facilities. This special provisions has been revised as follows:

Removed signature certification and added statement that the contractor, by signing the bid, is deemed to have signed and agreed to the provisions. Stated that prime contractors furnish notice to subcontractors and material suppliers.
