In view of the fact that many of the projects now programmed on secondary roads are approaching the magnitude and nature of roads on other systems, the same procedure should be followed in securing approval of geometrics. This procedure is set out in the Design Manual.

For short projects, such as bridge replacements, plan sheets may be used for strip maps to secure geometric approval. On these projects, only one strip map will be required. With approval of geometrics, right-of-way plans may be developed.

In submitting strip maps, information relative to sub-standard features should be furnished so that these features may be clarified.

In view of the above and present standards of procedure, "Supplementary Highways and Local Roads" circular letter No. 2, dated January 27, 1964, is rescinded.
