ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS

Attached are copies of the following new Job Special Provisions and revised Form SP-14. These will be used where applicable, beginning with the February 27, 1970 letting. They will possibly be included in some of the projects scheduled for the January 29, 1970 Letting, if timing permits.

PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE - PAVEMENT PROTECTION

This special provision expands the present Specification to include compressive testing requirements. It should be included in all projects with Portland Cement Concrete Pavement.

STANDARD CONSTRUCTION SIGNS

The present construction sign requirements have been expanded to provide reflectorized delineators at open trench locations. This special provision should be included in all projects with open trench (i.e., widening, curb and gutter, etc.).

METAL PIPE AND PIPE-ARCH CULVERTS

During development of the supplemental specification and drawing for precast flared-end sections, it was determined that no direct payment would be made for excavation and bedding. This special provision sets out a similar procedure for metal flared-end sections. This is now covered on the drawings, however, this special will eliminate any conflict.

AGGREGATE FOR PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE

This special provision expands present requirements for testing of the fine aggregate in Portland Cement Concrete. It should be included with all projects using Portland Cement Concrete.

BITUMINOUS MATERIAL

In order to institute a new procedure for acceptance of bituminous material by certification at all major supplying points, it is necessary to revise our present specifications to provide testing and certification procedures. This special provision allows this procedure and should be included in all projects containing bituminous material.
