Senate Bill No. 117 enacted by the 75th General Assembly is now contained in the revised statutes of Missouri for 1969 as Chapter 327. This statute provides for the creation of a State Board of Architects, Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors and prescribes the field of activity of each with certain general provisions.

The following requirements relative to plans for CART construction projects are required in order to comply with this statute.

Plans for public road work (when the work is of sufficient magnitude to require written plans and specifications) must be prepared by a Registered Professional Engineer or prepared under his immediate personal supervision. The seal of the Registered Professional Engineer is required on all plans. If such plans include plats and surveys, such as those required for procurement of additional right-of-way, the seal of a Registered Land Surveyor, together with his certificate as to such survey, will be required.

No changes are required in the procedure presently being used to initiate and process the CART Maintenance Program.

The requirements contained in this letter are not retroactive. Presently approved construction plans will be processed and carried to completion in accordance with past practice.

The requirements in this letter will be in effect for all CART construction plans submitted after this date.

All Presiding Judges are being notified of this requirement by a separate letter.
