Subject: Clarification of General Letter No. 36, 1970 and Design Manual Revision

ALL DIVISION AND DISTRICT ENGINEERS

We have been informed that some confusion has been caused by the wording in the first sentence of General Letter No. 36, 1970, on the subject of Metal Pipe and Pipe Arch Culverts.

This sentence was intended to explain that metal end sections are now covered under a different section known as Flared-End Sections. This is also true of concrete flared-end sections now covered under Flared-End Sections. The Job Special Provision of June 1970, Flared-End Sections, covers the usage of both concrete and metal end sections. It was not the intent to eliminate the use of metal end sections.

Revised copies of Section 9-10 and Figures 9-05.10 and 9-05.11 of the Design Manual are being forwarded under separate cover to holders of the Manual.
