**Attached are copies of revised General Special Provisions and Form SP-14.**

**A brief description of the latest revisions follows:**

**SP-14. Sec. 105 Control of Work, Sec. 501 Concrete, Sec. 803 Sodding, Sec. 1015 Bituminous Materials, Sec. 1018 Fly Ash for Concrete, Sec. 1019 Cement, and throw-in Use of Fly Ash in Concrete have been added.**

**Sec. 105. This revision allows the item of sodding to be accepted in line with current specifications for seeding and mulching.**

**Sec. 501. The revision allows Type I (PM) pozzolan modified cement in all general concrete construction except high early strength concrete.**

**Sec. 803. Revised the time period required for keeping sodded areas moist.**

**Sec. 1015. Deleted certain requirements for asphalt filler for undersealing pavements in general agreement with AASHTO and ASTM specifications.**

**Sec. 1018. This is a new specification covering the use of fly ash in concrete.**

**Sec. 1019. The revision allows Type I (PM) pozzolan modified cement in all general concrete construction except high early strength concrete and expands the allowed use of Type IP pozzolan cement to the same as allowed for Type I (PM).**

**Use of Fly Ash in Concrete - MR SP-31. This special provision is a new "throw-in" that should be included in all projects where concrete is used.**

**The above revisions are effective with the February 1986 letting.**
