Attached are copies of revised General Special Provisions and Form SP-14.

A brief description of the latest revisions follows:

SP-14. Sec 725 Metal Pipe and Pipe-Arch Culverts; Sec 726 Rigid Pipe Culverts, Storm Drains, and Sewers; Sec 730 Polyethylene Pipe Culverts; Sec 802 Mulching; Sec 1020 Corrugated Metallic-Coated Steel Culvert Pipe, Pipe-Arches, and End Sections; and Sec 1047 Corrugated Polyethylene Culvert Pipe have been added.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Contract Provisions. The revision allows contractors to count 60% instead of 20% of the expenditures to DBE suppliers who are not manufactures.

Sec 411. This revision deletes the time limitation on pumping of asphalt filler.

Sec 613. Revised to insure that the drilled holes will be blown clean to receive the bonding agent, to provide a smooth ride over the pavement repair, and to impose weather limitations.

Sec 702. Revised to make preboring a bid item.

Sec 712. This revision removes a conflict and directly specifies the type of fabric pad to be used.

Sec 725 and 726. These sections have been revised to be compatible with the new sections 730 and 1047.

Sec 730 and 1047. These are new specifications for corrugated polyethylene culvert pipe. It is intended that the corrugated polyethylene culvert pipe not be allowed for crossroad culverts at this time. Design parameters for usage will be developed and submitted at a later date.

Sec 802. Revised to include a provision for sampling and testing prior to approval and use.

Sec 1020. Revised to clarify the requirements for the base metal to be used in coupling bands.

Sec 1042. This revision requires priming of the face side of the structural signs only if priming is recommended by the enamel manufacturer.

The above revisions are effective with the March, 1988 letting.
