Subject: **Revised Job Special Provision**

Body

Attached are revised General Special Provision and a revised D-14 form which will be effective with the March, 1993 letting. Below is a summary of those revisions.

Sec 109: Measurement and Payment

Section 109.5 has been revised to allow for partial payment of structural steel which has been produced and delivered by the steel mill to the fabricator and is limited to contracts with more than 250 tons of steel.

Sec 703: Concrete Masonry Construction

Section 703.3.14.5 has been revised to allow the use of a finned float as a concrete surface texturing device.

Sec 725: Metal Pipe and Pipe-Arch Culverts

Section 725.1.2 has been revised by combining Groups I and II for pipes on low-type pavements with shallow fill heights and labeling it as Group A. Group III classification of pipe has been retained as shown and relabeled as Group B.

Sec 726: Rigid Pipe Culverts, Storm Drains, and Sewers

Section 726.1.2 has been revised by combining Groups I and II for pipes on low-type pavements with shallow fill heights and labeling it as Group A. Group III classification of pipe has been retained as shown but relabeled as Group B.

Sec 730: Polyethelene Pipe Culverts

Section 730.1.2 has been revised by combining Groups I and II pipes on low-type pavements with shallow fill heights and labeling it as Group A. Group III classification of pipe has

been retained as shown but relabeled as Group B.
