Attached are revised General Special Provisions and a revised form D-14 which will be effective in the May, 1992 Letting.

Sec 107: Legal Relations and Responsibility to the Public.

Section 107.11, Protection of Streams, Lakes, Ponds, and Reservoirs is revised to provide for disposal of portland cement concrete residue and wash water.

Sec 403: Asphaltic Concrete Pavement.

Section 403.6 is revised to eliminate the requirement for samples to be taken immediately behind the paver.

Sec 606: Guard Rail and Guard Cable.

The entire Section 606 is revised to provide description, materials, construction, method of measurement, and basis of payment requirements.

Sec 712: Structural Steel Construction.

Section 712.3.3.7 is revised, in particular, AWS Sec 5.3 Paragraph 5.3.1 and AWS Sec 5.4 - Sec 5.4 to modify welder qualification. AASHTO Sec 6.4 Paragraph 6.4.4 is added pertaining to the qualification of welders.

Sec 1015: Bituminous Materials.

Section 1015.1.2.2 is revised to eliminate the project number on the

bill of lading, manifest, or truck ticket for truck loads of bituminous materials.

Sec 1040: Guard Rail and Guard Rail Materials.

The entire Section 1040 is revised to provide material details for the revised Section 606.

Sec 1042: Highway Sign Materials.

Section 1042.2.8.4, Type L-4, Acrylic Plastic Characters, is revised to require a non-chalking white paint in the paint specification.

A revised special provision title for Price Adjustment for Fuel has been added to the revised D-14 sheet.
