The following is an index of general letters that were distributed during the calendar year

1992. The effective date, if applicable, and a brief summary are also enclosed.

General Letter No. 1: February 11, 1992: 1991 General letter Distribution index.

General Letter No. 2: February 11, 1992: Revised General Special Provisions and revised D-14 sheet, effective with the March, 1992 letting.

General Letter No. 3: February 11, 1992: General Special Provisions for Pavement Edge Treatment which replaces the special provisions for Edge Drop Off Treatment. This special provision is effective with the March, 1992 letting.

General Letter No. 4: February 28, 1992: General Letter specifying the information to be shown on the 2B sheet when Bid Item 206-35.00, Culvert Cleanout, is specified in the contract.

General Letter No. 5: March 2, 1992: General Letter listing the changes made to DESI Format in the district offices.

General Letter No. 6: April 3, 1992: Revised general special provisions and revised D-14 sheet, effective with the May, 1992 letting.

General Letter No. 7: April 9, 1992: A two-divisional letter from the Materials and Research Division and Design Division explaining procedures for implementing pavement edge drains for retrofit projects.

General Letter No. 8: April 15, 1992: A two-divisional letter from the Materials and Research Division and Design Division emphasizing the need for improved coordination concerning soil surveys.

General Letter No. 9: July 9, 1992: Revisions to sheet 2 of the special sheets in the Temporary Erosion Control Measures concerning estimated quantities of silt fence and straw bales needed for ditch checks.

General Letter No. 10: July 17, 1992: Letter outlining the need to begin retrofitting structural signs located behind guard rail or 30 feet from pavement edge with breakaway design features.

General Letter No. 11: August 11, 1992: Revised General Special Provisions and revised D-14 sheet, effective with the October, 1992 letting.

General Letter No. 12: August 11, 1992: Assigned permanent bid item numbers to the bid items contained in the Temporary Erosion and Sediment Control special provision.

General Letter No. 13: August 19, 1992: A special provision requiring substitution of Type 1 Preformed Marking Tape or Thermoplastic Marking Material for Type 2 Preformed Marking Tape in the August and September lettings was distributed.

General Letter No. 14: August 24, 1992: This letter provided advance notification and a brief explanation of revisions to drain basins and approach pavement standard drawings and bridge approach slab drawings.

General Letter No. 15: August 17, 1992: This letter provided clarification of payment procedures for Type 1 Preformed Tape or Thermoplastic Marking Material when substituted for Type 2 preformed tape as stated in General Letter No. 13, 1992.

General Letter No. 16: September 4, 1992: The letter provides instructions for electronically submitting leveling course project cost estimates to the headquarter's Design office.

General Letter No. 17: October 1, 1992: A two-divisional letter from the Bridge and Design offices explaining the new Bridge Approach Slab implementation and coordination requirements.

General Letter No. 18: October 14, 1992: Special provisions allowing the use of ET-2000 or SENTRE end terminals as equals for special end treatment on Type A guardrail were distributed. This provision eliminates classifying the ET-2000 and SENTRE end terminals as experimental items.

General Letter No. 19: October 19, 1992: Provides a job special provision to be included in all Traffic Control Plans concerning parking vehicles and storing equipment and materials on construction sites. This provision is effective with the November, 1992 letting.

General Letter No. 20: October 22, 1992: Revised General Special Provisions and revised D-14 sheet, effective with the January, 1993 letting.

General Letter No. 21: November 3, 1992: This letter provides notification of revisions to bid items for culvert cleanout, thermoplastic marking material, and removal of existing concrete pavement.

General Letter No. 22: November 6, 1992: This letter provides instructions for using pole and bracket cable for luminaires on signal poles.

General Letter No. 23: November 18, 1992: Provides job special provisions, bid item numbers, and instructions for implementing rumble strips to be constructed in concrete shoulders. Revised job special provision and bid item for Bituminous Rumble Strip.

General Letter No. 24: November 23, 1992: Provides a job special provision for use on projects when Rock Ditch Liner is specified, effective with the March, 1993 letting.

General Letter No. 25: December 15, 1992: This letter requires the use of the special provision titled Temporary Erosion and Sediment Control on all projects where temporary erosion control is required. This change is effective with the March, 1993 letting.

General Letter No. 26: December 15, 1992: Provides revisions to sheet no. 3 of the special sheets for Temporary Erosion Control Measures concerning the sizing of sediment basins. The revisions are effective with the March, 1993 letting.

General Letter No. 27: December 15, 1992: Provides a revised job special provision and bid item numbers for Rock Ditch Liner and Bedding Material. This general letter voids General Letter No. 24, dated November 23, 1992.

General Letter No. 28: December 15, 1992: Provides clarification on the payment for Pavement Removal, i.e. pavement that is to be broken up and left in place. It should be included in Removal of Improvements.
