Subject: Signal and Lighting Plans - Sheets D37A, D37C, Pull Box Special Sheets

Body

Some districts have found errors in their D37A and D37C sheets stored on CADD. The latest revision for these sheets is dated June 1, 1993 and was included in Design Manual Letter No. 6, 1993. Please check the drawings and if found incorrect, please contact this office and we will transfer the correct drawings. Please use these latest drawings for traffic signals currently being designed.

The pull box special sheet included with Design Manual Letter No. 6, 1993 showing preformed and concrete pull boxes has been revised to include an information block in the upper right corner. This drawing is being transferred to all districts. A copy of this drawing is also attached. Any signal or lighting plans specifying Type 1, 2 or 3 preformed pull boxes will require the addition of this sheet until it can be incorporated as a standard drawing. We recommend the use of preformed pull boxes whenever possible in signal and lighting designs, since they are less expensive than the concrete pull boxes.

Please be reminded that all signal and lighting plans should be submitted for preliminary review. Requirements for preliminary plans are in the design manual. If you have any questions, please call Rick Bennett at (314) 751-1409.
