Subject: **Revised General Special Provisions and Revised D-14 Sheet**

Body

Enclosed are revised General Special Provisions and a revised D-14 Sheet. The Revised General Special Provisions are effective with the June, 1994 letting. The following is a brief summary of the revisions.

Sec 105: Control of Work

Section 105.12 is revised to inform the contractor that he must obtain a permit to move equipment which is over legal width, length, or weight over any bridge or pavement other than that which is being constructed under the contract.

Sec 109: Measurement and Payment

Section 109.4 is revised to improve and clarify the current force account procedures.

Sec 404: Bituminous Mixing Plant

New Section 404.2.12.3 is added to cover methods of transferring mixture from mixing plant to surge bins.

Sec 503: Bridge Approach Slab

Section 503.2 is revised to include material requirements for polyethylene sheeting to be placed under the approach slab.

Sec 620: Bridge Approach Slab

Section 620.13.1.4 is revised to allow the use of removable pavement marking in lieu of permanent pavement marking for a maximum of five (5) calendar days before final marking is completed.

Sec 1018: Fly Ash For Concrete

Section 1018.4.4 is revised to require the location of the manufacturer & the name & location of the shipping facility to be shown on the bill of lading

Sec 1019: Cement

Section 1019.3.4 is revised to require the location of the manufacturer & the name & location of the shipping facility to be shown

on the bill of lading.

Sec 1042: Highway Sign Material

Section 1042.2 is revised to update & editorialize the section.

Table revisions are to correlate reflector specifications with industry & federal standards being used by most other agencies.

Sec 1050: Lumber, Timber, Piling, Posts, and Poles

Section 1050.2.2 is revised to add the grading requirements for wood guardrail posts & blocks made of Douglas Fir or Southern Pine.

Sec 1055: Concrete Curing Material

Section 1055.4 is revised to make reference to New Section 1058 for polyethylene.

Sec 1058: Polyethylene Sheeting

A new materials section for Polyethylene sheeting requirements is added.

Sec 1061: Electrical Conductors

Section 1061.4 is revised to provide for thermosetting polyethylene insulation and to delete insulation type THHW since it is no longer available.
