## Body

The purpose of this letter is to alert all District Utility Engineers, Transportation Project Managers, and Project Development Engineers to a change in the attached "Utilities DSP-93-26" job special provision. The column entitled "Status of Work as of date" has been renamed "Anticipated Relocation Completion Date".

When completing a Utilities job special provision for inclusion in a project, four categories should cover the majority of projects and utilities. These four categories are listed below:

1. Complete
2. Date of anticipated relocation completion (should have written dates, duration, or completion dates from the utility)
3. Relocation dependent on Stage Construction (include description)
4. Included in the contract

There will be instances when these above categories are not appropriate for your utility. In these instances, please contact the Technical Support Engineer for Utilities at General Headquarters Design for assistance.
