REVISIONS:

High Build Waterborne Pavement Marking Paint – JSP1501 – Eliminated the use of the double dropped wet reflective elements, and grooving on construction projects if a durable pavement marking product is not being used. Additional changes include thickness application rates, and bead requirements for divided major routes.

High Build Waterborne Pavement Marking Paint replaced:

- Wet Reflective Pavement Markings - JSP0806
- High Build Acrylic Waterborne Pavement Markings – Non-Std JSP

Contract Liquidated Damages – JSP1301 – Required the assessment of a full day's liquidated damages irrespective of the time of day the contractor completes

the work.
