MINOR REVISIONS: (ERRATA)

504.00H Sheet 2 of 3 – Revised sheet description in the title block to “Concrete Approach Pavement for Multi-Lane Pavements”

Sheet 3 of 3 – Deleted “for Two-Lane Pavements” reference in the title block since details on the sheet apply to both multi-lane and two lane facilities.

903.05H Sheet 1 of 2 – Revised post description location. Past revisions inadvertently placed post 1 on the right and post 2 on the left. Other minor corrections to the sheet consist of drafting corrections, addition of “Detail” labels for key locations and a revised slope convention reference in note (4).

Sheet 2 of 2 – Revised to provide “Detail” labels for the beam clamp, post base and beam splice details. Modified the elevation detail for post base to enhance detail of interior and exterior welds.

903.06H Sheet 1 of 2 – Revised post description location. Past revisions inadvertently placed post 1 on the right and post 2 on the left. Other minor corrections to the sheet consist of drafting corrections and a revised slope convention reference in note (4).

903.12X *Sheet 4 of 5* – Deleted reference to post type VIII that was inadvertently overlooked in the December 2007 revisions.

MAJOR REVISIONS:

607.11G *Sheet 1 of 1* – Modified this sheet to incorporate guidance for installing fencing at MSE walls.

902.00M *Sheet 1 of 2* – Deleted 48” maximum dimension for pedestrian push buttons.
