1	The following revisions are effective with the <b>June 2006</b> bid opening
SECTION	DESCRIPTION OF SPECIFICATIONS REVISIONS
304.4.3	New section added to address testing requirements for small quantities of aggregate base material.
606.50.2.4	This section was revised to specify a more angular graded material for bedding under guard cable.
620.2.1.8	This is a new section that addresses surface preparation prior to placing pavement marking.
620.2.3.1	This section was revised to provide flexibility in the type of retroreflector used to test pavement marking.
620.2.4.1	Amended to provide guidelines for testing when mobile retroreflectometers are used and when hand held retroreflectometers are used.
620.70.3.1.1	Revised this section to reinforce the use of covers on Type 1 TRPMs when used on surface treatment projects and added language to cover their use when not on surface treatment projects.
620.70.3.1.2	Amended to indicate Type 2 TRPMs use shall be as shown on the plans.
620.90.2.1	Amended the section to indicate the use of Type A epoxy pavement marking on pavements not open to traffic.

<b>620.90.2.2</b>	Amended this section to indicate Type B epoxy pavement marking to be suitable for all applications of pavement marking.
<b>620.90.3.1.1</b>	Revised the last sentence to say “to ensure delivery of the uniformly mixed components to the mixing unit.”
<b>620.90.3.1.5</b>	Revised to make the spec more performance based.
<b>620.90.3.3.8</b>	Revised to indicate cleaning requirements for new asphaltic concrete pavements. Renumbered existing section.
<b>620.90.3.3.9</b>	Existing Sec 620.3.3.8. Removed the reference of epoxy pavement marking. This section now requires all existing pavement markings to be removed to the extent that 95 to 100 percent of the existing marking is removed.
