<u>ITEM</u>	<u>REASON SELECTED</u>
<u>Pedestrian Lights</u> Architectural Area Lighting 'Providence' Fixture, in Black, on 14' ht. Black Pole	Selected to match those used on 47 <sup>th</sup> Terrace, and Troost Ave. from Cleaver Blvd to Brush Creek
<u>Street Lights</u> Kim High Pressure Sodium Roadway Fixture on 40' Round Tapered Galvanized Steel Pole with Black Finish	Selected to be the same style as the streetlights on 47 <sup>th</sup> Ter, (but the same color as the Pedestrian Lights).

Bench: Selected to match benches used throughout the area.  
Dumor, #58 with Custom Lettering on Castings:  
"KCMO PARKS, RECREATION AND BOULEVARDS"

Trash Container: Selected to match trash containers used throughout the area.
